Dear All,

On behalf of Mid Cornwall District, it gives me great pleasure to invite you to take part in Mid Cornwall's Coast 2 Coast and Beaver challenges. Please make sure you read all the paperwork carefully, and remember to book early as numbers are limited for both the events. Early bookings also carry a large discount (for prices see booking forms). Outline details of the two routes are below, further details will follow with your booking instructions.

Camping will be available for all taking part in the C2C Challenge.

The entry fee for 'Coast 2 Coast' covers the cost of the camping fee, Coast 2 Coast badge, and two meals (Saturday tea, and Sunday breakfast).

The Beaver challenge entry fee covers the cost of drinks, walking and a Beaver challenge badge and certificate.

The option of camping on Friday night for C2C teams, including breakfast and or transport on Saturday morning, are both available at an extra charge, the details of this are on the entry form.

Please note that no camping equipment can be put up at the Campsite at Nine Ashes until 3pm on Friday 16th April. All groups are welcome to come and pitch their equipment on Friday evening. The site will then be open until 9pm for pitching camping equipment. On Saturday the site will open for pitching camping equipment from 8am.

Please note due to the nature of the site and availability of facilities all catering will be provided centrally. Ample marquee and indoor space will be provided for shelter, so only hike or patrol tents will be needed for camping. Free hot and cold drinks will be available 24hrs and snacks will be on sale. Food will be available from Saturday Breakfast and hot and cold drinks from Friday 5pm.

Non walking leaders are welcome to camp for the weekend and we will happily cater for them, just book them in on the entry form. Please do not forget that all adults taking part in the event or staying on the campsite must have a current cleared Scout or Girl Guiding UK CRB.

Beaver Challenge Details

The Beaver walk is a Saturday afternoon event. The cost is £3.00 per walker and the Beavers need to bring a packed lunch. The route is circular, starting and finishing at the campsite consisting entirely of footpath walking.

Distance 3 miles

C2C Walk Details

This route is only for members of the movement aged 10 and above. The walk will start on Saturday morning at 7:30am from Par Beach. Space will be made available for kit storage at the campsite; also transportation of camping kit from the start to the campsite will be available. The route will be made up of coastal footpaths, footpaths, and some road walking. The route is around 22 miles back to the campsite on Saturday. At this point most walkers will camp for the night, or if you get there early enough you can continue and do the Sunday route on the Saturday.

Walking will restart on Sunday at 8:30am; the route will be approximately 12 miles in length. Along the total route there will be 10 or more safety checkpoints with water and several mobile First Aiders. Tuck will also be for sale along the route. When you reach the finish you will be bussed back to the campsite.
